

Wild West Winter Carnival Reining King & Queen Guidelines

You are the chairpersons for the following events; immediate past King and Queen are your Co-chairpersons.

Parades: Wild West Winter Carnival Night Parade, Shoshoni Flywheelers Parade in June, the Lander 4th of July Parade, and the Riverton Fair Parade in August. You could make an appearance at the 1838 Rendezvous, any appearance you make helps promote the Wild West Winter Carnival. We have two permanent floats.

Nominations for the following year's King & Queen: Visit clubs and organizations inviting them to select a couple from their organization. Promote our Winter Carnival events and tell them about your trip to St. Paul's Winter Carnival.

Royalty Coronation:

Royalty Brunch: Emcee Brunch. The St. Paul Royalty will provide entertainment. The Winter Carnival will pay for a silver plate with the new King & Queen's names engraved on it. The Bull is our host and sponsor along with the Riverton Jaycees.

In December check on your projects. The committee should have received your invitation from St. Paul. Also order sashes for the upcoming King & Queen. There are six sets of Royal Court Banners that are collected immediately after the prior year's Carnival is over (they cost \$30.00 each). These should always have red embroidery. Marilyn from Daisy Embroidery has been doing them but if someone else is interested we're happy to get bids.

January: Hurry! Hurry! Hurry!!!! It's almost here. The St. Paul Winter Carnival trip is over the last weekend in January (you probably leave Thursday). You will take gifts for their Royal Court and your sponsor. You will need buttons, and pins to give to collectors and spectators at the parade. We will give you over a hundred of last years WWWC pins to hand out at the parade. The Chamber will give you brochures; The Balloon Rally Board will supply you with pins, Wyoming cowboy pins from the state.
